Pursuant to re-assessment of the movement requirements of the Security Forces upon successful conduct of polling in the Parliamentary Constituencies of Baramulla & Jammu on 11th of April, 2019 and Srinagar & Kathua on 18th April 2019, it is hereby ordered that the regulation of civilian traffic between Srinagar & Baramulla, on National Highway-44, would now be limited to only one day a week, viz; Sunday.

This is in partial modification of Government Order No. 353-Home (ISA) of 2019 dated 03.04.2019.


