In terms of Rule 8 (b) of the Central Services (Leave Travel Concession) Rules, 1988, post-facto sanction is hereby accorded to the availing of Leave Travel Concession by Shri Sunil Kumar, IPS, IGP, Armed/IR Kashmir to visit Port Blair alongwith his three family members (spouse, son and daughter) with effect from 29.12.2014 to 07.01.2015 for the extended Block 2010-2013, subject to the following conditions that :-

- i. Neither the officer nor his described family members have availed LTC during the block 2010-2013.
- ii. Dependence of the family members on the Officer is established under the relevant rules and wife of the officer shall not claim reimbursement for the same separately.
- iii. Journey to Port Blair and back is performed by the shortest route.
- iv. Entry to this effect is recorded in the service book/character roll of the officer.
- v. The entitlement is regulated by the concerned DDO under rules.
