SRO 19 .- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 4 of the Jammu and Kashmir Public Safety Act, 1978, the Government hereby direct that in notification SRO 243 dated 27<sup>th</sup> April, 1978, after second proviso to paragraph 1, the following proviso shall be added; namely :-

‘the Indian tourists may be permitted to visit places beyond Panamik up to Warshi including Yarma Gompa/Yarma Gonboo Monastery’.
