Raman Kumar, PID No. EXJ-006516, on treatment availed by him at DMC Ludhiana, SMVD Narayana Hospital Katra and Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute and Research Centre , New Delhi, in relaxation of rule 6 (1) of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Medical Attendance-cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Reimbursement of charges is restricted to items/procedures admissible under rules for the period of hospitalization and cost thereof to the extent of rates as applicable to such items/procedures at AIIMS, New Delhi.
- ii) All relevant medical bills/vouchers shall be got verified from relevant Medical Authority of the hospital where from treatment has been taken.
- iii) Follow-up(s), if any, is regulated under rules.
- iv) Essentiality certificate on Form 2 issued by the hospital authority is obtained and kept on records.
