Ex-post facto sanction is hereby accorded to the reimbursement of medical expenses incurred by Shri Hurdesh Kumar, Head Assistant on his self treatment at Fortis Hospital Mohali in relaxation of Rule 6(1) and 6-A of the J&K Civil Services (Medical Attendance cum Allowance) Rules, 1990 subject to the following conditions:-

- a) Reimbursement of charges shall be restricted to items/procedures admissible under rule for the period of hospitalization and cost thereof shall be restricted to the extent of rates as applicable to such items/procedures at PGI Chandigarh.
- b) All relevant medical bills/vouchers are verified from the relevant medical authority of the hospital where from treatment has been taken.
- c) Essentiality certificate on form-2 issued by the concerned hospital authorities where from treatment has been availed is obtained and kept on records.
- d) Follow up(s), if any, is regulated under rules.
- e) Certificate from Competent Medical Authority (Director Health Services/Principal GMC/other) is obtained to certify that the drugs and services charged are reasonable and to establish the genuineness of the treatment availed in the said hospital.


