Review of Penalty imposed upon Shri Saroop Singh, Inspector, EXJ- 006539, in terms of Rule 377 of Police Rules, 1960.

## Government Order No.73 -Home of 2023 Dated:10.02.2023

Whereas, in pursuance of the report submitted by the Inquiry Officer, in an Inquiry ordered by the PHQ vide Order No. 2286 of 2021 dated 31.07.2021, the DGP, J&K imposed a penalty of 'Censure' upon Shri Saroop Singh, Inspector, EXJ-006539, vide Order No. 2153 of 2020 dated 10.08.2020; and

Whereas, the matter regarding the imposition of penalty was examined in the Home Department and it was observed that the penalty of 'Censure' imposed by the DGP, J&K upon Shri Saroop Singh, Inspector was not commensurate with the misconduct of the official, warranting review of the penalty, in terms of Rule 377 of Police Rules, 1960; and

Whereas, the matter was placed before the Competent Authority and the Competent Authority upon consideration of all the facts related to the case, decided that the penalty of 'Censure' imposed by the DGP needs to be enhanced.

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that the penalty of 'Censure' imposed upon Shri Saroop Singh, Inspector, EXJ-006539, vide DGP Order No. 2286 of 2021 dated 31.07.2021, shall and shall always be

deemed to have been enhanced to the penalty of 'fine not exceeding one month's pay'.
