A Five days Course on '**Advance Digital Forensics**' scheduled to be held at the S.V.P. National Police Academy, Hyderabad from December 11-15, 2023 for the officers of the rank of Addl. Superintendent of Police to Inspector General of Police.

2. The objective of the Course is to familiarize the participants with types and sources of digital evidence and develop their skills in:

- The principles of Digital Forensics and its sub branches.
- Role of digital forensics in investigation of the cases.
- Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) to be followed in handling different types of digital evidences.
- Analysis of different types of storage media and collecting evidence from it.
- Mobile forensics.

3. It is requested that **eligible officers (main- 03 & reserve-02)** of the level of Addl. Superintendent of Police to Inspector General of Police from your State/UT/Organization may please be nominated. **Officers having knowledge in IT & Cybercrime or posted in Cyber Crime divisions are to be nominated. The Course is fully residential and the participants of the Course will be staying in the accommodation provided by the Academy. **The expenditure to be incurred on boarding and lodging of the participants shall be met by the Academy.** However, the expenditure on account of travel of officers for attending the Course may be borne by the respective State / Central Government Departments. It is informed that as per SOP of the Academy, those Officers against whom any criminal case, DE/PE etc. is in currency or contemplated are **not eligible** to undergo any training programme/course/seminar/workshop at the Academy. Hence, nominations of eligible Officers may only be sent accordingly.

6. A list of Officers who had given their willingness to **develop domain expertise in 'Cyber Crime & IT'** is enclosed herewith as **Annexure-'A'** to this letter. It is requested that while nominating Officers for above-said Course, the **DGs may give preference to these Officers from their respective States/UTs.**
