In terms of rule 6 of J&K Civil Services (Medical Attendance-cum-Allowances) ,Rules,1990 and as recommended by Director General of Police J&K, Ex-Post facto sanction is hereby accorded to the reimbursement of medical expenses incurred by ASI Oveer Singh, PID No.PHT895785 of Crime Branch Jammu for treatment of wife at CMC Ludhiana w. e .f 30.09.2015,29.10.2015, subject to the following conditions:

- (i). All the relevant medical vouchers/bills shall be verified and countersigned by the competent medical authority of the hospital where from treatment has been received.
- (ii). That the drawing and disbursing officer shall reimburse the medical claim, strictly in accordance with the standing Medical Rules, after fulfillment of all codel formalities.
- (iii). The reimbursement of medical expenses shall be restricted at the rates applicable in AIIMS, New Delhi and PDI Chandigarh respectively.
