In terms of Rule 61 & Rule 73 of J&K Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1979 read with SRO-274 dated 30.05.2013, sanction is hereby accorded to the grant of 12 months study leave, in favour of Mrs. Anu Dutta, SI, PID No. ARP065596 for undergoing Masters Degree in Police Administration at Centre of Police Administration, Punjab University, Chandigarh, w.e.f. 30.08.2017 subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The case is genuine and course of higher studies has due regard to the exigencies of Public Service and would be of definite advantage to the department.
- ii. There is acute dearth of Police Officers with a Masters Degree in Police Administration in the department and acquiring of higher qualification by the official is absolutely necessary.
- iii. The work load on account of her study leave is managed through internal arrangement.
- iv. The officer shall not have any superior claim over her seniors for consideration for promotion after acquiring higher qualification.

- v. The course undertaken is purely in public interest, and shall prove beneficial to the department.
- vi. The stipend, scholarship etc, if any, received during study leave is adjusted in her leave salary.
- vii. The University/Institution wherefrom the official intends to obtain Master Degree is recognized by UGC".
- viii. The official shall execute a bond in Form-6, in terms of the rule 64(3) of the Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1979.
