Subject: Accord of post-facto sanction to the availing of Home Town Leave Travel Concession (LTC) by Shri Navin Aggarwal, IPS (Retd).

In pursuance of Rule 8(a) of the Central Services (Leave Travel Concession) Rules, 1988, post facto sanction is hereby accorded to the availing of Home Town Leave Travel Concession by Shri Navin Aggarwal, IPS (Retd), the then Director Civil Liaison, Home Department, to visit his home town Bareli (UP), alongwith his family members comprising of wife and son with effect from w.e.f. 25.06.2021 to 30.06.2021 for the block 2020-21, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) The officer or his dependents have not availed of such concession earlier during the LTC Block 2020-21.
- ii) Entry to this effect is recorded in the service book of the officer.
- iii) The family members accompanying the officer are wholly dependent on him.
- iv) Journey to Bareli (UP), is performed by the shortest route.
- v) The entitlement is regulated by the concerned Drawing & Disbursing Officer under rules.
