Sanction is accorded in favour of Constable Manjit Singh, PID No. ARP-176344, to pursue higher studies i.e **B.A**, through Distance Mode of Education, from Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU), subject to the following conditions:

- i. The official shall pursue study course before and after the normal working hours of the office and holidays.
- ii. The completion of the course shall be without detriment to the efficient discharge of his official duties. If at any stage, it is found that the official has been neglecting his duties for sake of his studies, the permission shall be withdrawn at any moment without assigning any reasons, besides inviting disciplinary action.
- iii. The permission shall not entitle him to claim leave either for preparation or for the duration of the examination and that leave, if any, required for the purpose shall be sanctioned subject to its admissibility and also administrative interest, in terms of relevant rules.
- iv. The University/Institute as well as the course is recognized.


