The re-engagement shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The engagement shall be purely on contractual basis for a period of six months.
2. They will be paid an honorarium, at the rate of the last pay drawn minus pension/commuted pension, and will be entitled to allowances as admissible to a temporary Government employee.
3. They shall be terminated in case of unsatisfactory performance without giving any prior notice.
4. They shall have to give one month's notice before leaving the contractual engagement and in case they fail to do so, one month's honorarium shall be forfeited for which they shall have no claim, whatsoever.
