Subject: Adoption of date of birth in respect of SgCt Javid Ahmad, PID No. EXK-983569.

Reference: Letter No.Esst/DOB-18/2016/23767-69 dated 16.04.2019 and No.Esst/DOB-18/2017/31621 dated 04.08.2023, of the Police Headquarters, J&K.

Whereas, the Police Headquarters vide referred letters submitted case of SgCt Javid Ahmad, PID No. EXK983569, for adoption of his date of birth as **21.10.1977** instead of **21.01.1977**, on basis of recommendations of its "Date of Birth Committee"; and

2. **Whereas,** on the basis of the information and other relevant documents relevant to the case, it came to fore that SgCt Javid Ahmad, PID No. EXK983569, was initially appointed as Constable in J&K Police, in the year 1998, and during preparation of the Character Roll, his date of birth came to be recorded as 21.01.1977(**Twenty First of January N.H Seventy Seven in words**), on the 1st page of Character Roll, without any cutting or mutilation; and

3. **Whereas,** the case was examined in light of the factual details, documents made available by the PHQ and the extant rules governing the subject. It was observed that the designated committee in PHQ has not considered the relevant rule position as envisaged in J&K Police Rules, 1960 and the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulation, 1956, while recommending the case of the official for adoption of his date of birth as 21.10.1977; and

4. **Whereas,** the Article 35-AA(c & d) of J&K Civil Services Regulations Volume-1 explicitly lays down that the alteration in date of birth can be effected within 05 years from the date of entry into Government Service.

5. **Whereas,** it was observed that the official has failed to make a representation for alteration/modification of his recorded date of birth within the prescribed time limit i.e. five years from the date of

appointment, as required under the provisions of rules and the case has been brought to the notice of the Administrative Department after a lapse of almost two decades. As such, the case for change of Date of Birth warrants rejection.

Now, therefore, the claim of the official namely SgCt Javid Ahmad, PID No. EXK983569, having been considered, in terms of relevant rules governing the subject is, for the reasons recorded hereinabove, found devoid of any merit and hence rejected. The date of birth of the official shall continue to be treated as **21.01.1977**, as recorded on his Character Roll in the year 1998, at the time of his appointment.


