**Subject: Departmental action against Shri Raies Ahmad Mir,
Dy.SP KPS125763-imposition of penalty thereof.**

References: Letter No. 42/GAZ/CIV/PHQ/2019/20913 dated 27.12.2019, of Director General of Police, J&K.

Whereas, Police Headquarters, J&K. vide communication No. 42/GAZ/CIV/PHQ/2019/20913 dated 27.12.2019, had recommended initiating Departmental proceedings against Mr. Raies Ahmad Mir, Dy.SP KPS125763, on the basis of preliminary enquiry done by Additional SP traffic, City Srinagar and some other complaints lodged by private individuals regarding misuse of his official position; and,

Whereas, vide memorandum dated 24.11.2022, Articles of Charge were served upon Mr. Raies Ahmad Mir, Dy.SP. In response, Mr. Raies Ahmad Mir, Dy.SP, the then Dy.SP, Traffic, submitted his reply on 19.12.2022 ; and

Whereas, the reply of Mr. Raies Ahmad Mir, Dy.SP was examined, it was observed that the officer has refuted all the charges and accordingly, vide Government order No. 52-Home of 2023 dated 31.01.2023, Sh. Intiaz Ismail Parray, IPS (AGMUT:2009) DIG Training, PHQ, J&K was appointed as Inquiry Officer to conduct an enquiry into the charges framed against Mr. Raies Ahmad Mir, Dy.SP, KPS-125763; and

Whereas, Inquiry Officer vide communication dated 18.07.2024, submitted Inquiry report wherein it was reported that the charges regarding issuance of informal slips to traffic violators, issuance of hand written chit to a tipper and retention of fitness certificate of a tipper were not substantiated on the basis of Forensic Science Laboratory report which indicated that the hand writing on the paper slips did not match with delinquent officer and in absence of any supporting document respectively. However, the charge of physical manhandling by the Dy.SP or his subordinate staff (PSOs/SPO) has not been ruled out by the Inquiry Officer; and

Whereas, the Enquiry Report alongwith all other related documents was placed before the Competent Authority; and,

Whereas, on basis of the fact that the Inquiry Officer has not ruled out the charge regarding physical manhandling by the said Dy. SP or his subordinate staff, accordingly, it has been decided to impose the penalty of Censure in terms of Rule 30 of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

Now, therefore, in view of above, the penalty of "Censure" is hereby imposed upon Mr. Raies Ahmad Mir, Dy.SP KPS125763, in terms of Rule 30(i) of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.
