The undersigned is directed to state that Department of Personnel and Training has been organising Mid-Career Interaction between the Armed Forces and Civil Services Officers in collaboration with the Ministry of Defence for the last many years. The basic objective of this programme is to provide exposure of IAS/IPS/IFoS and other civil Services' officers to the military to meet unforeseen situations at short notice. Such interactions are likely to benefit both the Armed Forces and Civil Services officers by mutual learning from each other's strengths and also by imbibing the best points of each other's work culture, ethos and customs. This, in the long run, it is expected to help them combat future challenges to national security in a better manner.

2. The Joint Civil-Military interaction courses are conducted at the tactical and operational levels. A detailed schedule is prepared by the DoP&T, Training Division in consultation with Ministry of Defence for the various programmes to be conducted at the various Training Institutes in various Regions of the country every year. 
