A 03 days Course on 'Policing for Missing and Victimized Children' is scheduled to be held at the Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel National Police Academy, Hyderabad from August 17-19, 2022 for the IPS officers of the rank of Addl. Superintendent of Police to Inspector General of Police.
